

STBC COVID19 Controls for Communion Services – 1st April 2021 and onwards

These controls are specified in the COVID Risk Assessment that has been carried out specifically for Communion Services

These are in addition to the Controls specified for attendance at Services.

The full Risk Assessment can be found on Safety Notice Boards, on our Church Website or from the Church Administrator.

Pray

- that the controls listed below would work effectively
- that they may be relaxed further in the not too distant future
- that our gatherings, virtual and physical, would be a blessing to us and glorifying to our God

Prior to the service

- The Duty Steward will set out the Prepacked Communion Cups (including wafers) on a tray on a table at the centre of the meeting space
- The service leader will bring the tray to you at the appropriate time in the service for you to take a cup
- You may remove your mask.
- As we prepare to eat the bread, you should remove the top seal on the cup to reveal the wafer
- As we prepare to drink the “wine” you should remove the second seal to reveal the “wine”
- Once finished, you should put your mask on again
- At the end of the service, please dispose of your cup in the bin by the door on the way out.
