

## **STBC COVID19 Controls for Singing @ Sudbourne Baptist Chapel**

*These controls are specified in the COVID Risk Assessment that has been carried out for Outdoor Singing in the Carpark at Sudbourne Baptist Chapel*

*The full Risk Assessment is available on request from the Church Administrator.*

### **Pray**

- that the controls listed below would work effectively
- that no one would be exposed to the virus or otherwise injured during this event
- that this gathering would be a blessing to us and glorifying to our God

### **Duty / Car Park Stewards**

- Arrive 30 minutes before singing and park in Meadow
- Remind everyone of the need to observe 2m social distancing from those not in household group
- Assist people in leaving site safely after singing is finished

### **Congregation**

#### **Thinking of coming to the Outdoor Singing....**

- If significant rain is likely, we may cancel, check emails before leaving home
- Anyone who is in a vulnerable category are advised not to attend, or to use the drive-in option. Please let Matt know in advance if you would like to use this
- Anyone
  - with COVID19 Symptoms should not attend
  - who has been advised by Test and Trace service to isolate should not attend
  - who is living with somebody who has shown symptoms and is awaiting test results should not attend.
- Anyone who develops COVID-19 symptoms during the gathering will be sent home and advised to follow the stay at home guidance
- Facemasks are not required but you can choose to wear one if you wish
- Toilet facilities are available in the Chapel following the normal one-way system but it would be much better if you "go" before you leave home.
- Song sheets will be emailed out so you can print your own or download to Smartphone or Tablet.
- It may be cold and breezy so wrap up warm
- The meadow may be damp under foot, so wear good shoes/boots

#### **Arriving at Site**

- Try and be parked in the meadow opposite the Chapel by 5 minutes before the singing is due to start and in the Carpark in time for the start

## **The Congregation**

- If you are bringing children with you, please keep them in your household group
- Stay within 1 m of your seat which will ensure 2m distance from other groups
- A limited number of song sheets will be available, but much better if people can print off pdf carol sheet or download to smartphone or tablet
- No drinks will be available, please bring your own if required
- Avoid physical contact with others outside of family group
- If feeling unwell notify Duty Steward

## **After the service**

- Leave the area as directed by Service Leader, implementing any further instructions given
- If you are staying for another service, please enter the building as normal
- If leaving the site, please make your way to your car, observing 2m social distancing and leave via the normal way, watching out for cars that may be arriving.
