Dear Parents/Carers

It is great that Sunday Club and Mini Sunday Club are now able to start as of this Sunday, and we are really looking forward to seeing the children again.

We have reviewed our risk assessments and you are welcome to see the latest version, but we need to draw your attention to the following points:

1. COVID Symptoms

If your child has any Covid symptoms please do not let them attend and [get a test booked](#).

In the event of a positive test result, the [normal isolation procedures](#) should then be followed for them and their contacts.

2. Sunday Club children:

Please drop your children off at the YOUTH HALL DOOR at Sudbourne, from 10:20am onwards. There will be hand washing/sanitising available during the session and we will be encouraging the children to make use of these.

For children in school year 7 and above and for leaders of the group there is currently an expectation that they will wear masks when it is not possible to have a 2m+ distance from each other. Please can these children have a mask available to wear, should the activity require it. For the most part they will probably NOT need to wear it, as we are able to distance and will have a good air flow, with doors/windows open. We have a supply of face masks available at church if any year 7+ forget to bring their own. Primary school children do not need masks.

Please collect your child from the back door again after the service has finished. Parents should not come into the room where the club is held and do not need to wear masks when waiting outside. Please follow normal social distancing procedures in the car park, as outlined in the church safety measures.

3. Mini Sunday Club children:

Please take your children, (no more than one adult per child if possible to reduce congestion) to the MIDDLE ROOM at Sudbourne, via the main worship area. They can be dropped off from 10:20am onwards. Parents/Carers need to wear masks when inside the church building, including when dropping off children. Please then use the same door to return to the main worship area, and try to maintain social distancing as you go!

After the service please use the same routes to collect your children.

We would like to draw parents' attention to the availability of free [Lateral Flow Tests](#) which the Government is encouraging families to make use of as an extra precaution.
